How to reach Poznań

Air travel:

Poznań Ławica Airport is located 7 km from the city centre. You can get to Poznań Airport via Frankfurt, Munich or Warsaw, or you can check direct connections with your local airport here: <https://www.airport-poznan.com.pl/en/flight-connections/timetable>

Train:

Poznań is well connected with Warsaw and Berlin (2,5h time travel). Poznań Main Railway Station (Poznań Główny) is located in the city center 10 minutes walk from the University.

How to reach the University

Poznań University of Economics and Business (the Training School and Workshop venue) is located in the city center, at Niepodleglosci street 10.

Taxi:

From Poznań Airport you can take taxi (approx. 50PLN=10EUR).

Public transport:

Public transport is well developed in Poznań with both bus and tram network which covers City Centre and the suburbs. From Poznań Airport you can take Bus 59. You can buy tickets in the ticket machine outside the terminal. Payment in cash (PLN) or card. One single ticket costs 4,60PLN (1EUR); 7-days ticket costs 47PLN (10€).

Public Bike system:

There is an extensive public bike system in the city. There are bike stations near Airport and next to the University. In order to use the public bike you need to register online. All information you will find here: <http://nextbike.pl/en/cities/poznanski-rower-miejski/>

Useful information

Currency: Polish zloty PLN, 1EUR = 4,2 PLN

You can pay by VISA or MasterCard in many hotels, shops and restaurants. Money exchange points are located at the airport or in a lot of banks close to the University.

Electrical outlets and plugs are French standard (TYPE E). Participants need to bring their own adapters.

About Poznań

Poznań, with over half-a-million residents, is situated in the most economically developed region of Poland, closer to Berlin than to Warsaw. It is best known for its renaissance Old Town and Ostrów Tumski Cathedral, where the history of Poland started. Today, Poznań is an important cultural, business and education (about 140,000 students) centre with many regional customs such as traditional Saint Martin's croissants and a local dialect.

Accommodation

Poznań is very busy International Trade Fair center, therefore participants are encouraged to book hotel in advance.
